

General terms and conditions for the use of cookies

Cookies

In order to ensure the proper functioning of this website, we sometimes store small data files called cookies on your device. This is a common practice on most large websites.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website stores on your computer or mobile device when you browse it. With this file, the website retains information about your actions and preferences (such as login name, language, font size and other display settings) for a certain period of time so that you do not have to enter them again the next time you visit the site or browse its individual pages.

The website uses cookies for the following purposes:

Analytics cookies - we use Google Analytics cookies to analyse how visitors use the website and how they behave. We can then use the results to improve and simplify the usability of the website. Google processes the data collected through the website in an anonymous form.

Third party cookies - the website allows cookies from several third party social plugins. This allows users to share website content on certain social networks. These plugins also improve and simplify the user interface of the website. For example, with the Facebook plugin on the website, users can easily share content from the website with their friends on the social network. The data (used) collected by these third parties through social plugins is exclusively intended by this third party.

Enabling/disabling and removing cookies

You can delete cookies automatically or manually using your browser. You can also specify that certain cookies do not need to be placed. Another option is to change your browser settings so that you receive a message whenever cookies are stored. If you delete cookies in your browser, they will be placed again with your consent when you visit our website again.
